Since 1228, Ashford Castle has welcomed some of the most discerning guests through it's fabled doors and continues to this day to offer the warmest of welcomes, be it the first or one of many stays. Food and wine have long been the cornerstone of hospitality at Ashford Castle and nothing epitomises this more than the inspired Cellars at Ashford Castle. The Cellars date back to the 17th Century and were originally used as both coal storage and the service entrance. To this day, the original coal hatch can still be found in the tunnel.

With great care and thoughtfulness the Ashford Castle Wine Cellar was refurbished to house some of the greatest wines ever made. Our Wine Tastings offer guests the opportunity for both the novice as well as the aspiring wine connoisseur, a range of varietal, regional and classic wines across several different tastings. We are proud to offer vintage wines by the glass using the latest wine preservation technology, 'Coravin,' allowing guests to enjoy the most sought-after wines by the glass, including the likes of Château Cheval Blanc and Château Petrus

The Wine Geese are also well represented on the list, showcasing the great Irish influenced wines that are made by those of Irish ancestry. From Old World classics such as Château Lynch Bages and Château Phelan Segur, to New World champions like the O'Dwyer Winery in Clare Valley, Australia and Róisín Curley in Burgundy.

Wine Tastings are available from 12:00 – 17:30 daily. For tastings outside of these hours please do enquire and we will aim to facilitate depending on what availability allows. Guided by our expert team of Sommeliers, these private masterclasses last in the region of 45 minutes to 1 hour. Do note that due to these being tutored tastings, we request for all guests to choose one tasting. Please allow a minimum of 2 hours' notice for wine selection.

The journey begins with a candlelit wine tasting thoughtfully curated and hosted by our sommelier team which is led by Paul Fogerty, featuring five exclusive pairings accompanied by elegant canapés.

Guests are then invited to Stanley's for an intimate dining experience shaped by the collective talents of our kitchen team which is led by Executive Head Chef, Liam Finnegan.

A seasonal three-course menu is prepared, showcasing the finest estate-grown ingredients. The evening concludes with a decadent dessert course created by the Pastry team, who will prepare a palate-cleansing sorbet which will be followed by an exquisite chocolate creation featuring seasonal flavours.

WINE GEESE BORDEAUX €250

Did you know that these famous Châteaux have profound connections with Ireland? Enjoy these to find out the beautiful and fascinating history behind each of these wines and the Irish Wine Geese.

Château de Fieuzal, Pessac Leognan, owned by the Quinn family since 2021, Château Lynch Bages, Pauillac, family originally from Galway, where the original Castle still stands in the heart of Galway city or go down the street to discover where the Kirwan's traded, Château Kirwan, Margaux, head to Tipperary and discover from where the Phelan family came from, Château Phélan Ségur Saint-Estèphe.

ASHFORD CASTLE PREMIER €800

Some wines are reserved for the most noteworthy of occasions. In this tasting, we aim to discover the complexity and subtlety of these masterfully aged-wines and learn to distinguish between the nuances which set them apart on the world stage.

Le Dôme, Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France. One of the 'garagiste' movement.

Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido Bolgheri Sassicaia, Italy. The original Super Tuscan.

Château Lafitte-Rothschild, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France. Rated as a First Growth under the 1855 Bordeaux Classification and one of President Jefferson's favourite wines.

Insignia Joseph Phelps, Napa Valley, California. According to Robert Parker, "Insignia remains one of the world's finest Cabernet Sauvignon dominated blends.

ASHFORD ICONIC €1500

Our Cellars at Ashford Castle date back to the 17th century and have housed some of the greatest wines ever made. This rare tasting opportunity allows you to experience four of the finest wines ever produced in concert. Guiding you along the journey for a flawless tasting, this is one to savour and remember for years to come.

Petrus, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France. The King of Merlot with 'The little bump', in reference to the small hill made up of 40 million year old blue clay.

Quintarelli, Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Italy. Regarded by many as the greatest of all Amarone producers. Quintarelli's Amarones are only released in excellent vintages.

Opus One, Napa Valley, California. Robert Mondavi of Napa fame and Baron Philippe de Rothschild of Château Mouton Rothschild began their collaboration to merge old world and new world wine styles into one grand opus back in the 1970's.

Penfold Grange, Australia. The first vintage of Penfolds Grange was made on an experimental basis in 1951 by Penfolds winemaker Max Schubert, and is now one of Australia's top wines.



RED WINE TASTINGS

ASHFORD VAULT €1750

These selected wines are expressions of the finest by the glass wines produced from around the world. The opportunity to taste these side by side allows for a unique tasting, representing the echelon of what great wine should be.

Echezeaux Dujac, Grand Cru, Burgundy, France. A great wine started by Jacques Seysses, the son of a biscuit maker, who purchased Domaine Graillet in 1967; he renamed it Domaine Dujac, a play on his first name (Domaine du Jacques).

Reserva Special, Unico, Vega Sicilia, Ribera del Duero, Spain. Wine expert Hugh Johnson, after comparing Rioja producers stated: "Vega Sicilia is the Latour; but Latour of a vintage that has raisined the grapes and fried the picking crews."

Case Basse, Soldera, Toscana IGT, Italy. The estate has expansive rose gardens – containing more than 1500 species – and woods to encourage biodiversity.

Château Cheval Blanc, Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France vines have been grown since the 14th Century at this spot with a split of 60% Cabernet Franc and 40% Merlot. One of the leading wine estates in Saint-Émilion.
