COCKTAILS

Martini £25

The iconic cocktail's history begins with a drink called the Martinez – which is also the name of a town in California which claims to be the geographical birthplace of the drink we now call the Martini. It covers the story of Julio Richelieu's bar in Martinez around the year 1870. Julio made a gin and vermouth concoction and dropped an olive into the drink before serving it to the customer.

The Egerton Martini style, called a 'bone dry', 'naked' or 'direct' martini, is made by pouring gin from a bottle stored in the freezer at -22C 'directly' into a chilled glass with two dashes of vermouth. There is no stirring, no shaking, and no dilution. The extreme cold knocks back the perceived alcoholic strength, making these Martinis all too easy to drink.

One Martini is all right, two is too many, three is not enough.

Signature Martinis £21

Our five signature martinis are created from a selection of our homemade syrups. Using locally sourced fresh fruits, our syrups are a perfect balance between fruit juice and sweetness. They are then uniquely paired with our natural rose, orange blossom or geranium essence water, inspired from a family-owned Tunisian farm.

Choice of: Lychee, Passion Fruit, Pomegranate, Cherry, Raspberry

Shaken Martinis £21

Choice of: Lemon Drop, French, Chocolate, Espresso, Apple Sour, Violet

Negroni £19

The most widely reported version of this drink's origin is that it was invented at Caffè Casoni in Florence, Italy in 1919. Legend tells that Count Camillo Negroni asked his friend, bartender Fosco Scarselli, to strengthen his favourite cocktail – the Americano – by replacing the soda water with gin. Scarselli added an orange garnish, rather than the lemon you'd usually get with an Americano, and the drink took off.

Before long, everyone was coming into the bar for a 'Negroni.'



Manhattan £19

As with many classic cocktails, the exact origin story of the Manhattan cocktail is lost in time. The most popular theory is that the recipe was invented by Dr Iain Marshall in the early 1880's for a party by Lady Randolph Churchill, the mother of Winston Churchill. The supposed explanation behind the name of the drink is because this party was held in the Manhattan Club in New York.

Margarita £19

One story goes that the drink was first created by Mexican restaurant owner Carlos (Danny) Herrera in 1938 for gorgeous Ziegfeld showgirl Marjorie King. King was allergic to all forms of alcohol except tequila but didn't like to drink the stuff straight. Herrera supposedly solved the problem by adding salt and lime and creating the world's first margarita.



Mojito £19

When bartenders from the United States migrated to Cuba seeking jobs during the Prohibition era they brought cocktail culture along with their shakers. In Havana, at established watering holes like El Floridita—where expatriates like Ernest Hemingway would seek respite from the city's sultry heat—they found expert cantineros who were already mixing local rum with fresh fruit juices. As the 1930s gave way to the war years and then the 1950s, a distinctive Cuban rum highball-on-ice canon developed and solidified.

Old Fashioned £19

The origin of this cocktail can be traced to an edition of The Balance and Columbian Repository dated 13th May 1806 in which Harry Crosswell answered a reader's query from the previous week, defining a cocktail for all posterity as 'stimulating liquor, composed of spirits of any kind, sugar, water and bitters.' Aside from the missing orange peel, most drinkers will recognize that list as a blue print for what we now call an Old Fashioned.



Whiskey Sour £19

While the Brandy Sour may once have dominated the Sour family of cocktails, it is the Whiskey Sour that thrived during the Prohibition-era and proved the most popular and endearing style of Sour.

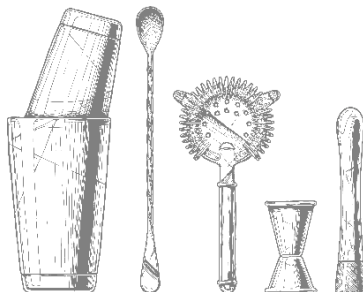

ESPRESSO

SINGLE £7 / DOUBLE £8

A shot of concentrated coffee, made by forcing very hot water at a high pressure through finely-ground coffee beans.

AMERICANO £8

Single shot of espresso with hot water giving it a similar strength to, but different flavour from, traditionally brewed coffee.

LATTE £8

A milk coffee that is made up of a shot of espresso, steamed milk and a final, thin layer of frothed milk on top.

MATCHA LATTE 10

Originating from Japan. Matcha is finely blended leaves from green tea plants. This powder is whisked into steamed milk.

CAPPUCCINO £8

A milk coffee that is made up of a shot of espresso and an even distribution of foamed milk and steamed milk.

FLAT WHITE £8

A milk coffee with a blend of smooth foamed milk poured over a shot of espresso with a final, thin layer of steamed milk.

MACCHIATO £8

A milk coffee that is made up of a shot of espresso and steamed milk only.

MOCHA £8

A milk coffee with a shot of espresso, chocolate and topped with steamed milk and a thin layer of steamed milk.

CORTADO £8

A shot of concentrated coffee with an equal measure of steamed milk, possessing a much stronger taste than a latte.

ICED COFFEE £8

A version of your favourite coffee with a combination of ice and your choice of syrup
Syrups: vanilla, caramel, chocolate and strawberry

HOT CHOCOLATE £8

All food and beverage prices are subject to a 15% discretionary service charge. VAT is included at the current rate.
