## London City Airport by Docklands Light Railway and Tube

London City Airport has its own station on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR). Services run every eight to 15 minutes. Fares on the DLR are the same as those on The Tube. The DLR connects to the Tube at Canning Town and Canary Wharf (Jubilee Line) or Bank (Central Line). For more information, and details of fares, visit the Transport for London (TfL) <u>website</u>. If you're going to be using London's public transport system, it's worth buying an <u>Oyster card</u> or using a contactless debit card for easy payment.

## London City Airport by Taxi

There are usually taxis queuing for customers at London City Airport. The cost of the cab is metered and displayed inside the cab. Only use a reputable mini-cab and never use unauthorised drivers. The City Airport <u>website</u> has average fares and you can ask the driver or mini-cab company how much your journey will cost beforehand.
