Gatwick Airport by Rail

The Gatwick Express is the fastest way into Central London. There are 4 trains an hour between Gatwick Airport's South Terminal and London Victoria Station every day from 5.40am to 23.10am. Journey time is 45 minutes, and the service is non-stop to Victoria. For more information, and details of fares, visit the Gatwick Express <u>website</u>.

You can also get the First Capital Connect train to London Bridge, City Thameslink, Blackfriars, Farringdon or St Pancras International. Gatwick Airport by Taxi

There are usually taxis queuing for customers at Gatwick airport. Only use a black cab or reputable mini-cab and never use unauthorised drivers.
